ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There is no pre-requisites or specific entry requirement for this qualification. This course is available to all international students and Oscar Institute requires that students are able to provide evidence that they:

- 01 Have demonstrated an IELTS level at score of at least 6.0 or equivalent (test results must be no more than 2 years old) or demonstration of successful completion of at least General English at Upper Intermediate or English for Academic Purposes Upper Intermediate level.
- 02 Have a suitable level of language, literacy, numeracy and digital to complete course requirements with or without additional support that Oscar Institute is able to provide. Must be a proficient user of advanced calculators.
- 03 Have successfully completed Australian Year 12 or equivalent, or must be of mature age with adequate LLND skills.
- 04 Are at least at age of 18 on the date of course commencement.
- 05 Have completed a qualification equivalent to Australian Advanced Diploma level (AQF Level 6) or higher.



Prior to the finalisation of enrolment, all prospective students are required to complete a Language, Literacy, Numeracy and Digital (LLND) assessment. This assessment assists OSCAR Institute in determining the student's suitability for the course and identifying any additional support requirements during their study.
